## GAME CONDUCT District Commissioners & State Tournament Directors

- 1. All games will be played under rules and regulations covered in the Professional Baseball Rule Book, Rules and Regulations of Babe Ruth Baseball and any State Tournament rules.
- 2. Games will be kept moving at all times. No unnecessary delay or mound conferences, etc. will be permitted.
- 3. Anyone, including players, coaches and managers acting in a non-sportsman like manner shall be removed from playing field or ballpark immediately and could cause disqualification from tournament.
- 4. Managers, coaches and players shall wear full uniforms according to Baseball Rules. Whiles in uniform neatness is a must.
- 5. Protective headgear must be worn at bat and on bases.
- 6. Equipment bats , gloves, helmets etc. shall be stacked neatly in the dugout in their proper places at all times.
- 7. Only Players, coaches, the manager and batboy shall be allowed in dugouts. Players must stay inside dugouts.
- 8. Masks with throat protector will be required at all times when warming up the pitcher, whether on the field or in the bullpen. (This means anyone warming up the pitcher).
- 9. No **TOBACCO** will be permitted on the playing field, dugout or restroom by a manager, coaches or player of a team while engaged in a regular scheduled game.

## SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. The District Commissioner or Tournament Director shall have the authority to remove any player, coach or manager for actions detrimental to Babe Ruth Baseball. Any misbehavior or misconduct on or off the field could cause the disqualification of a manager, coach, player or the entire team from tournament (This includes parents teams are responsible for their fans).
- 2. The tournament is under the jurisdiction of the District Commissioner and Tournament Director.
- 3. The Protest Committee shall have final authority in all protest (Protest Committee must be three people).
- 4. The Protest Committee shall be appointed by the Tournament Director at the start of each game.
